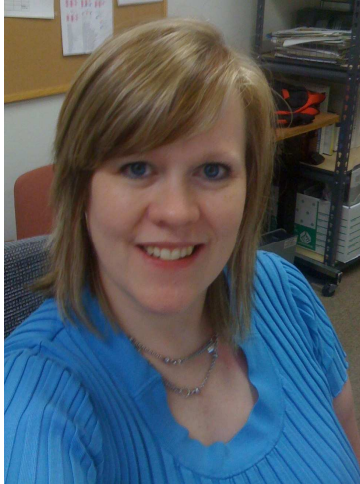


Kellie Ottmar
